3. Principal's Report

- Kids had a wonderful time during the readathon and it was very well received by the kids.

Astrodome starts April 24th for kids in grades 4 & 5 and this aligns well with the curriculum and was funded by School Council

Projections for this upcoming school year are looking good so far. There are 3 options for how the classrooms will divide up and moving forward we are recalling families with kids at Sibbidle Kiddle back to copperfield. This means that families who may have attended kindergarten there are now being told they are to return to copperfield. Exception would be any kids entering into grade 5 would be allowed to stay.

Due to more students returning we would need to turn our current learning commons into the copper gallery. For Lunch supervision it is unknown exactly what that will look like right now but options include. Tables set up around the learning commons in the gallery, or lunch in classrooms.

We had had extra funding for literacy intervention come through the school.

Copperfield is also going to be a busing school next year. With that in mind the planters that are in the front of the school are going to be a bit of a hazard with the bussing. Further discussion needed to determine how to move the planters and how much that could potentially cost.
