Re: Radon gas study at Copperfield Elementary School

Earlier this year, a radon gas study was conducted in 27 CBE schools. This work was initiated as part of a change in the building code when our new schools were designed and constructed and also included several older schools.

Detectors were placed throughout the school by a certified Radon Professional and left for about three months between October and March of this school year. The devices were then sent for analysis.

The CBE Indoor Environmental Quality team received the reports. The results confirm that the levels in your school are well within the Health Canada guideline for radon (below 200 Bq/m3) and no further action is required at this time.
